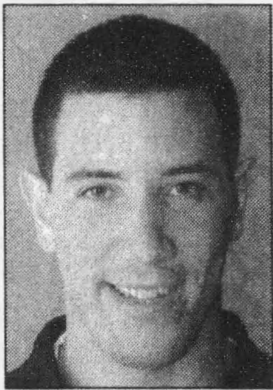

An All-American, he was second in points in the Dual County League and fourth in total points in Eastern Mass. as the Patriots had an impressive 10-5 campaign

that ended with a loss to power Lincoln-Sudbury. In his career he has more than 40 goals and 40 assists. DiMare pulled a trifecta in his senior season, earning all-star honors in football, basketball, and lacrosse. He will attend Springfield College this fall and will play both football and lacrosse.
